



- You must have 10 CTS/Fine Arts/PE/2nd Lang credits to graduate. It is recommended that you take these in your Grade 10 year.
- You must have 10 credits at the 30-level (in addition to ENG & SOC)
 - Take courses that will take you through to graduation.
- 9 credits in Religion are required to graduate
 - Religion courses can be taken in any order. There are no prerequisites!
 - We suggest you target Religion 35 and Religions of the World 30 as they also count toward your 30-level credits.

So what courses should I pick?

- Pick courses you have the pre-reqs for.
 - For example, you can't take Art 20 if you haven't taken Art 10.
- Stay away from AP courses if you are not passionate about the subject.
 - AP classes tend to move quicker and cover material in more detail. Passion is a must.
- Start to think about the classes you will need for any post-secondary education.
 - Myblueprint can help you out with this.


Spares
